UIM Rules for River Marathon Racing will apply

#### Regulations:

UIM rules for River Marathon Racing will apply as well as the following:

ALL racers will be required to complete a medical questionnaire as requested by CBF.

ALL New racers must have an orientation course & driving test and should start in FX class.

ALL Boat must start in the 70m staging area.

ALL Drivers require CBF Medicals.

ALL racers MUST have their Pleasure Craft Operators License.

In order to race, each boat must be equipped with all the items on the attached checklist.

All Boat drivers, navigators, and drivers of chase vehicles must have a valid CBF membership; these will be available for purchase at registration.

Motors of the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place boats in each class will be subject to tech inspection immediately after the last Leg of the race, at Peace Island Park Greenspace. At request of race captain.

ANY racers caught cheating with their engines will have their motors confiscated and SOLD with proceeds to charity; this racer will be banned for 3 races.

No Oxidized Fuel allowed.

World Anti-Doping Alcohol Code in effect suspensions issued after 0.03 alcohol level.

The Overall Canadian Winners will be based on total time for the season for all CBF sanctioned races; this will be sponsored by Outlaw Eagle Manufacturing. The winning boat will be allowed to run (Canada # 1). The winning boats will have competed in all CBF sanctioned races.

Race fuel will NOT be provided

#### "Unlimited" Jet Class – EM3 SERVICES INC.

300 series Recommended Number (U300)

- Hull any shape or material with a minimum length of 16 feet (4.88m)
- Unlimited engine restrictions or modifications, any exhaust c/w mufflers
   Jet Engines do not require mufflers
- Propulsion jet drive
- Roll bar (well mounted & braced) chrome moly recommended
- Onboard breathing system recommended

#### "A" Jet Class - SPONSORED BY FORT MOTORS

200 series Recommended Numbers (A200)

- Hull any shape or material with a minimum length of 16 feet (4.88m)
- Engine displacement shall not exceed 470 cubic inches (7700 cc) or AMS 565 'Spec Engine' with appropriate restrictor plate.
- Superchargers, blowers & turbos are allowed at 1.8 x cubic inch ratio
- Diesel engines are not subject to any multiplication factors to obtain their racing class irrespective of whether forced induction is used.

- Hull any shape or material with a minimum length of 13 feet (3.96) No Glass Windshields
- Engine GM ZZ4 355 HP CRATE engine GM part #24502609 or GM ZZ5 CRATE engine GM #19301294 or SP350 crate engine part #19333157 or CT350 CRATE engine part #19258602, GM CRATE ZZ6 part #19351533, (not allowed USA), GM CRATE CT400 part #19386104 (not allowed USA), all with GM stock intake.
- To allow a ZZ4 to be changed to a ZZ6 but you would have to change the heads, intake, rockers and all gaskets




