DO NOT speak to the timers regarding a protest or a penalty will result.

UIM Rules for River Marathon Racing will apply.

Regulations

UIM rules for River Marathon Racing will apply as well as the following:

ALL racers will be required to complete a medical questionnaire as requested by CBF

ALL NEW racers must have an orientation course & driving test and should start in FX

ALL Boats must come off step the 70m staging area

ALL drivers require CBF Medicals

ALL racers MUST have their Pleasure Craft Operators' Licence

In order to race, each boat must be equipped with all the items on the attached checklist

ALL Boat drivers, navigators, and chase vehicle must have a valid CBF membership; available for purchase at registration ALL crews will be required pit passes in order to access pits

Motors of the 1^{st} , 2^{nd} , and 3^{rd} place will be subject to a tech inspection immediately after the last leg of the race, at request of race captain

Any racers in CX & FX caught cheating with engines will have their motors confiscated and SOLD with proceeds to charity; the racer will be banned for 3 races

No Oxidized Fuel allowed in CX, FX, or SPEC

World Anti-Doping Alcohol Code in effect, suspensions issued after 0.03 alcohol level

The Overall Canadian Winners will be based on total time for the season for all CBF sanctioned races; this will be sponsored by Outlaw Eagle Manufacturing. The winning boat will be allowed to run (Canada #1). The winning boats will have competed in all CBF sanctioned races

Race fuel will not be provided

- Hull any shape or material with a minimum length of 16 feet (4.88m)
- Unlimited engine restrictions or modifications, any exhaust c/w mufflers
- Jet Engines do not require mufflers
- Propulsion jet drive
- Roll bar (well mounted & braced) chrome moly recommended
- Onboard breathing system recommended

"Spec" Jet Class – SONOSORED BY GOODLO HOLDINGS

300 OR 200 Series Recommended Numbers (U200)





- 11. Any racers in SPEC, CX or FX caught cheating with engines will have their motor confiscated & sold with proceeds to charity, this racer will be banned for the season
- 12. On engine tear downs "All Gaskets at Owners Expense"
